



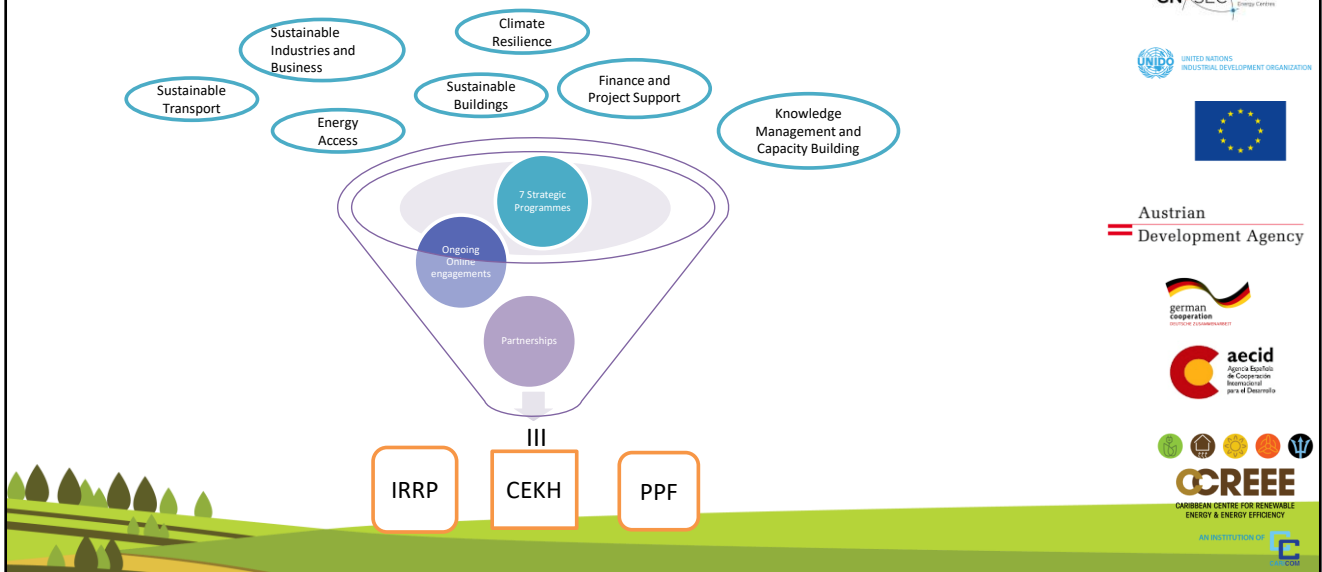

- Supporting the transition to low-carbon, secure and resilient future energy systems at **regional** and **national** levels

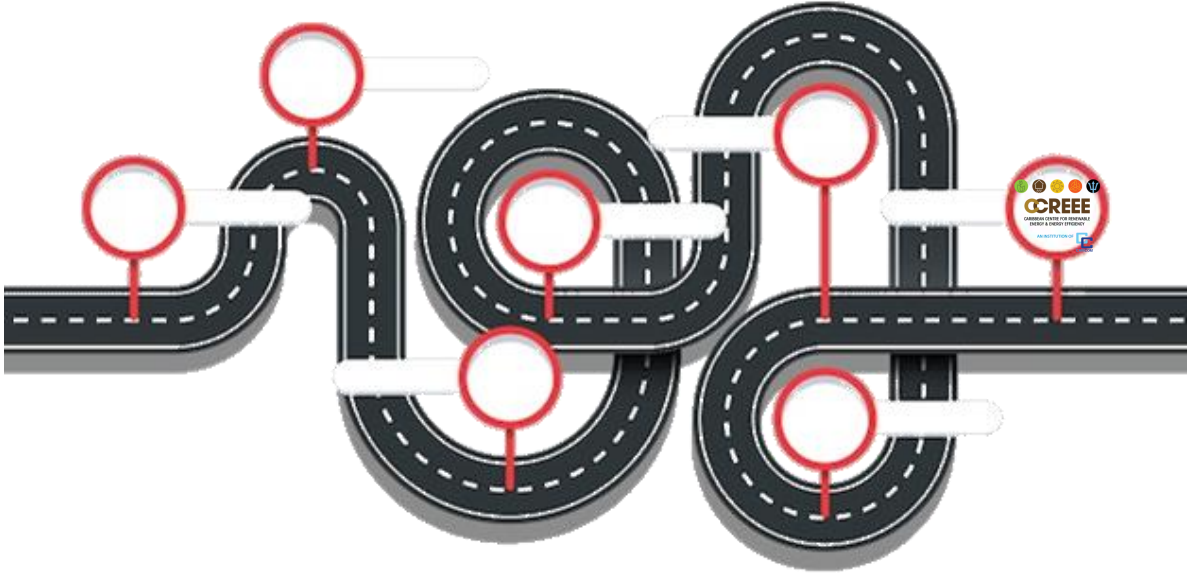

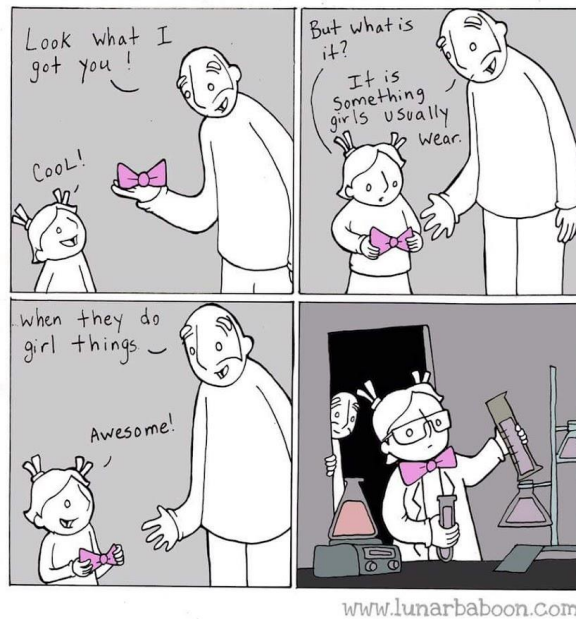
